Next Meeting—in Little Rock

The next meeting of the Mid-South Chapter will be Thursday, November 20, 2003, from 11 a.m. to 12 noon, and it will be held in Little Rock, Arkansas. Rosie Dixon, of the *Arkansas Democrat-Gazette* will be our host.

The meeting will be held in the East Room of Little Rock's Main Library at 100 Rock Street in downtown Little Rock. (Please note: the scheduled location is different from the location mentioned in the minutes.) Skip Rutherford, of the Clinton Presidential Foundation, will speak.

After the talk, the chapter will adjourn to the nearby River Market for a dutch treat lunch. The River Market is a collection of shops and stalls making up an indoor public food market, Ottenheimer Market Hall with hours from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m., Mondays through Saturdays. It is located at 400 President Clinton Avenue, a short walk from the Library.

About Little Rock and the River Market District

Both Market and Library belong to the River Market District and as such are part of a \$300 million development project utilizing the Arkansas River, the riverfront, and existing historic structures. The still-under-construction Clinton Presidential Library will become a major part of the area.

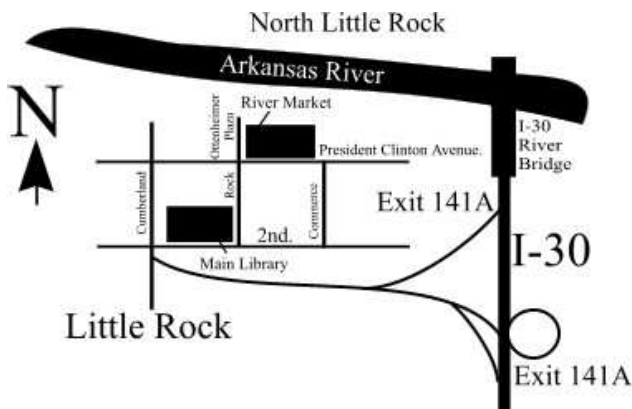

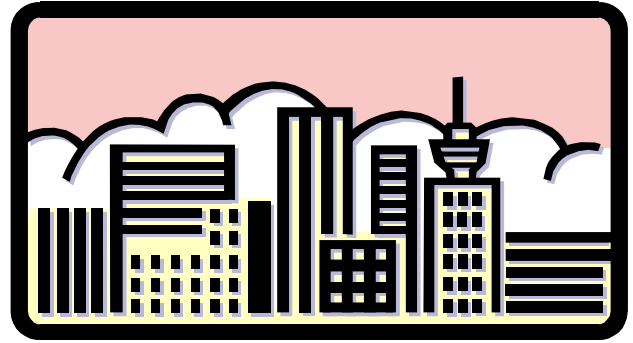

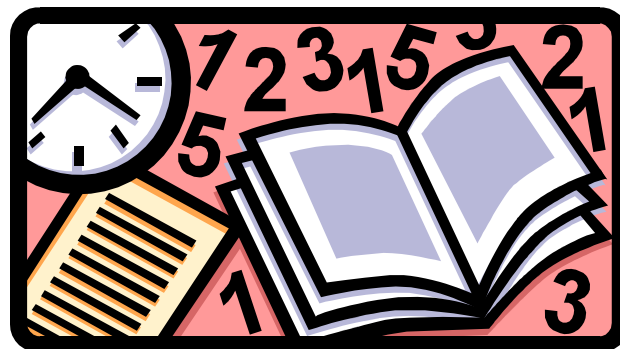
